How to block a website using the URL Filter

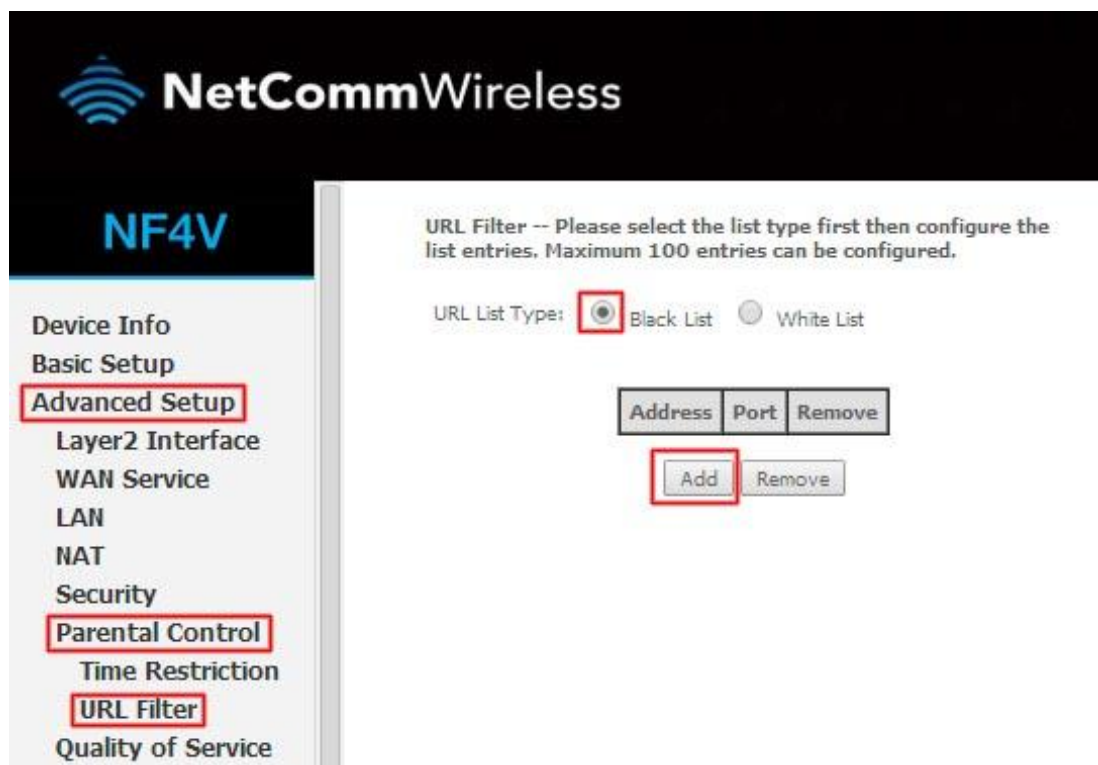
This guide will take you through the steps of blocking specific websites from the internet using the URL filter.

LOGGING IN TO THE WEB INTERFACE

1. Open a web browser (such as Internet Explorer, Google Chrome or Firefox), type **http://192.168.20.1** into the address bar and press **enter**.
2. At the login screen, type **admin** into both the Username and the Password fields and click **OK**.



3. Click on the **Advanced Setup** menu at the left of the page, then click on **Parental Control** option and then click on **URL Filter** option.



4. Select **Black List** as the URL List Type.
5. Click the **Add** button.
6. **Type in the URL** of the website that you want to block.

Parental Control -- URL Filter Add

Enter the URL address and port number then click 'Apply/Save' to add the entry to the URL filter.

URL Address:
Port Number: (Default 80 will be applied if leave blank.)

7. Click on **Apply/Save**.

8. You will now see that the website you added has now been added on to the list. The listed website will not be accessible by any computer connected to the NF4V.

URL Filter -- Please select the list type first then configure the list entries. Maximum 100 entries can be configured.
