# About Factory Resets

A factory reset on the NF18MESH returns all settings to the default settings as they were when shipped from the factory.



**Important** – It is particularly important to perform a factory reset after upgrading the NF18MESH firmware to ensure the firmware installation is completed correctly.

## Factory Reset Methods

There are two methods that can be used to perform a successful factory reset:

- ▲ Use the NF18MESH's graphical user interface (GUI) to complete a factory reset.
- ▲ Manually perform a factory reset using the reset pinhole at the back of the NF18MESH.

This guide will explain both methods to complete a successful factory reset.

# Web Interface Factory Reset

## Log in to the Web Interface

- 1 Open a web browser (such as Internet Explorer, Google Chrome or Firefox), type following address into the address bar and press enter.

<http://cloudmesh.net> or <http://192.168.20.1>

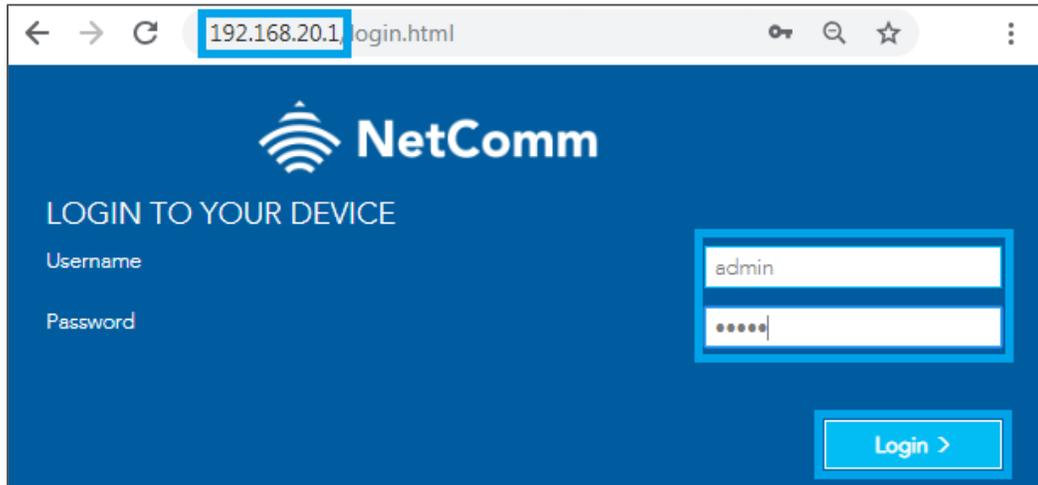
Enter the following credentials:

Username: admin

Password: <The password printed on the back of the modem>

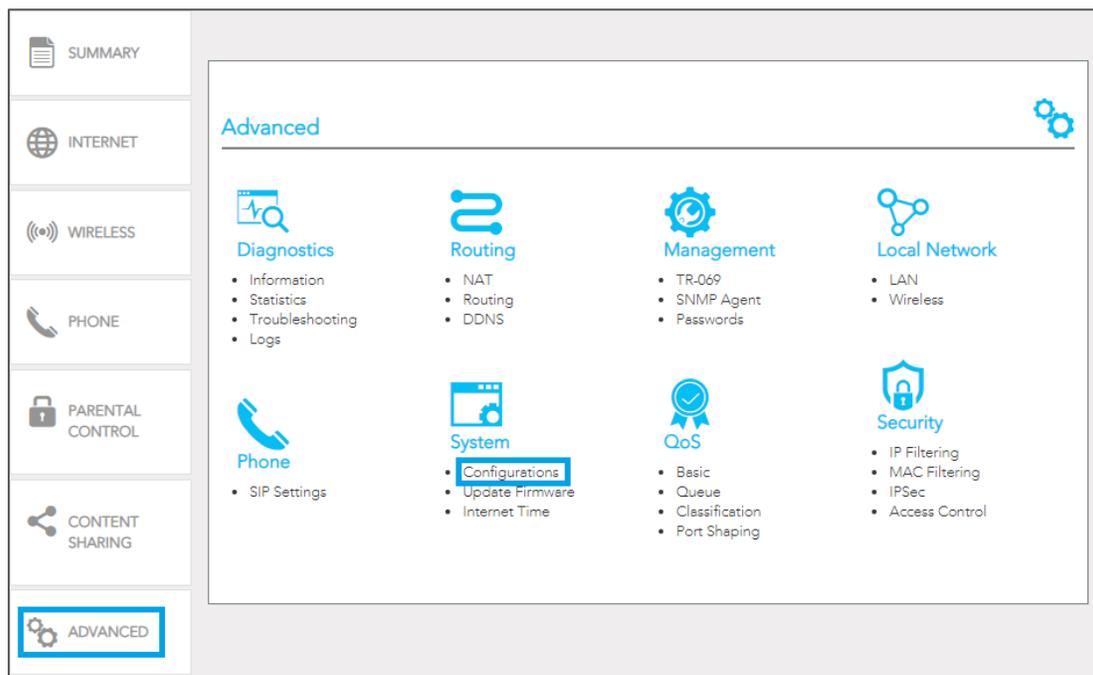
then click the **Login** button.

**NOTE – Some Internet Service Providers use custom password. If login fails, contact your Internet Service Provider. Use your own password if it is changed.**



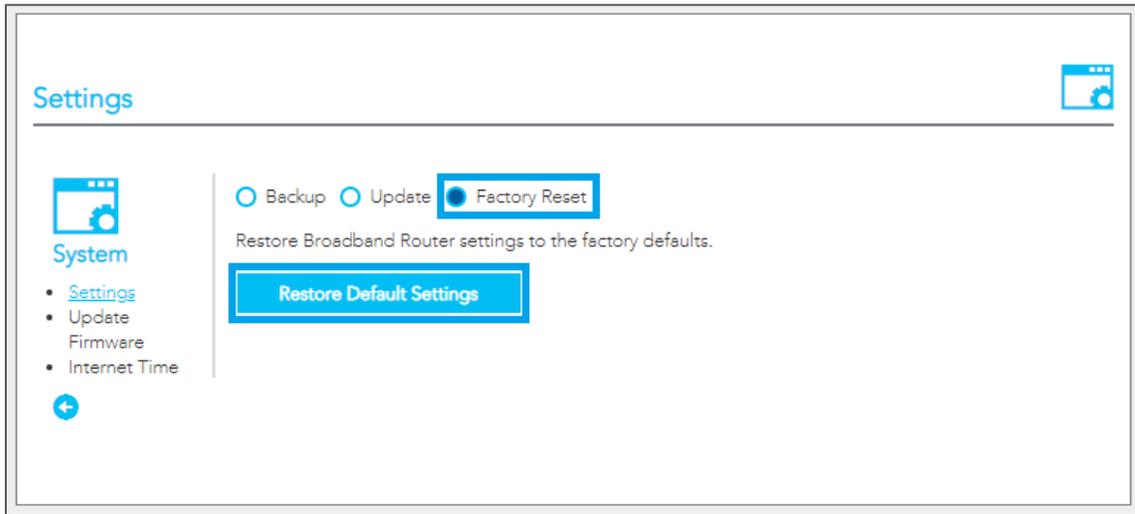
## Restore Default Settings from Web interface

- 1 Click on the **Advanced** menu on the left-hand side of the screen, then click on the **Configurations** option in the **System** group.



*Tools – Navigate to Advanced Configurations*

- 2 To reset the NF18MESH to its factory settings, select the  **Factory Reset** radio button and click the **Restore Default Settings** button.

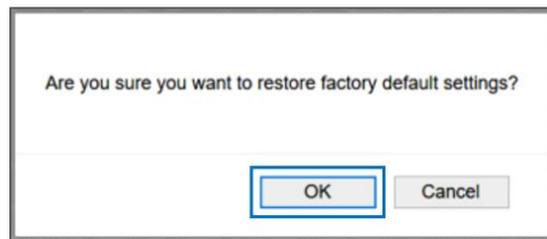


*Restore Default Settings*



**Note** – You may also perform configuration Backup and restore configuration from this page.

- 3 A pop-up dialog box will prompt: “Are you sure you want to restore factory default settings?”

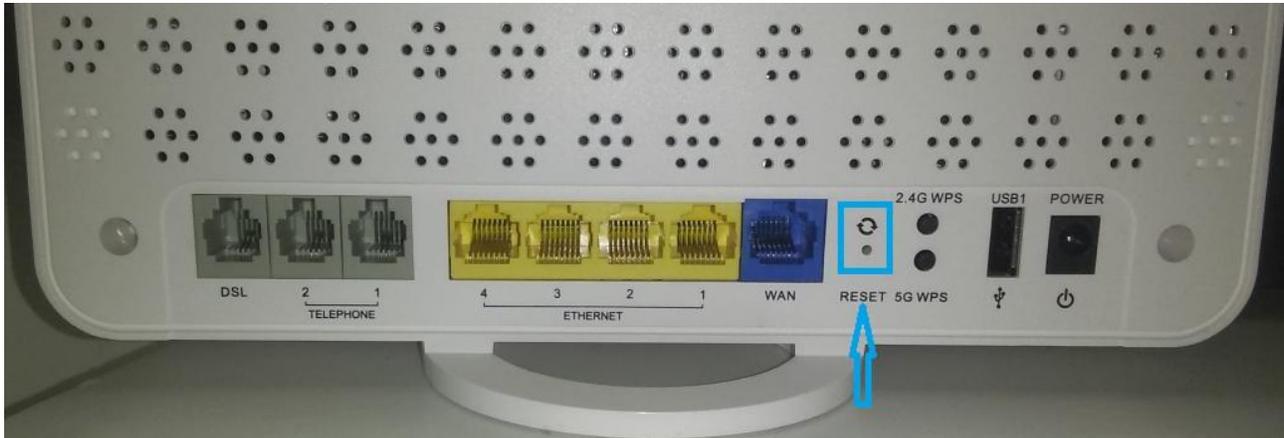


*Reset command confirmation dialog*

- 4 Click **OK** to confirm the reset.
- 5 The NF18MESH will reboot.
- 6 After the NF18MESH has rebooted you will need to log in to the NF18MESH using the default credentials printed on the sticker and re-enter your broadband connection settings such as your **ADSL/VDSL User ID** and **Password**, etc. Please use the **Quick Start Guide** to set up your router.

# Manual Factory Reset

- 1 Ensure the NF18MESH is powered on.
- 2 On the back side of the NF18MESH, there is a small hole in the plastic with the word "**Reset**" printed above it.
- 3 This is the recessed reset button:

- 4 Insert the end of a paper clip or other rigid, thin piece of metal into the **Reset** pinhole and depress and hold in for 10-12 seconds.
 

If this does not happen:

  - a Disconnect the power supply cable for 30 seconds and then reconnect it.
  - b Then depress the **Reset** button and hold in for 10-12 seconds.
- 5 The NF18MESH is back to its factory defaults, you now need to reconfigure the broadband settings via the user interface.



**Note** – If you had previously backed up your configuration, you can now restore your settings by uploading your **.config** file.

- 6 To reconfigure the broadband settings:
  - a Open a web browser (such as Internet Explorer, Google Chrome or Firefox), type <http://192.168.20.1> into the address bar and press **Enter**.
  - b At the login screen, type the **User Name** and the **Password** as printed on the sticker and click **Log In>**.
