NF18ACV Port Triggering Setup Guide


If you have a VPN client software such as Cisco VPN client or Nortel connectivity client' running on your computer behind the NF18ACV, and if you are not able to connect to VPN through please refer to the instructions below.

Log in to the web interface

Open a web browser (such as Internet Explorer, Google Chrome or Firefox), type http://192.168.20.1 into the address bar and press enter.




2 Click on the **Advance Setup** menu at the left of the page, then click **Port Triggering** option from the **NAT** submenu and then click the **ADD** button.

- 3 Please leave **User Interface** as default.
- 4 Select **⊙** Custom application and type an Application Name. Example: VPN
- 5 Add the following ports: TCP 1723 / UDP500 / UDP1701 and click on Apply/Save.



Once the port triggering rules have been created as shown below you should be able to establish your VPN connection.
