# **About Factory Resets**

A factory reset on the **NF20MESH** returns all settings to the default settings as they were when shipped from the factory.



**IMPORTANT** – It is particularly important to perform a factory reset after upgrading the NF20MESH firmware to ensure the firmware installation is completed correctly.

### **Factory Reset Methods**

There are two methods that can be used to perform a successful factory reset:

- 1. Use the NF20MESH's graphical user interface (GUI) to complete a factory reset.
- 2. Manually perform a factory reset using the reset pinhole at the back of the NF20MESH.

This guide will explain both methods to complete a successful factory reset.



# **Web Interface Factory Reset**

### Log in to the Web Interface

Open a web browser (such as Internet Explorer, Google Chrome or Firefox), type following address into the address bar and press enter.

### http://192.168.20.1

Type "admin" in the Username and password printed on the back of the modem in the Password fields and click the **Login** button.


**NOTE** – Some Internet Service Providers use custom password. If login fails, contact your Internet Service Provider. Use your own password if it is changed.





## Restore Default Settings from Web interface


1. Click on the **Advanced** menu on the left-hand side of the screen, then click on the **Configurations** option in the **System** group.



Tools – Navigate to Advanced Configurations



 To reset the NF20MESH to its factory settings, select the Factory Reset radio button and click the Restore Default Settings button.




Restore Default Settings



NOTE – You may also perform configuration Backup and restore configuration from this page.

3. A pop-up dialog box will prompt: "Are you sure you want to restore factory default settings?"

- 4. Click **OK** to confirm the reset.
- 5. The NF20MESH will reboot.
- 6. After the NF20MESH has rebooted you will need to log in to the NF20MESH using the default credentials printed on the sticker and re-enter your broadband connection settings such as your ADSL/VDSL User ID and Password, etc. Please use the Quick Start Guide to set up your router.



# **Manual Factory Reset**

- 1. Ensure the **NF20MESH** is powered on.
- 2. On the back side of the **NF20MESH**, there is a small hole in the plastic with the word "**Reset**" printed above it.

This is the recessed reset button:

3. Insert the end of a paperclip or other rigid, thin piece of metal into the **Reset** pinhole and depress and hold in for 10-12 seconds.

If this does not happen:

- A. Disconnect the power supply cable for 30 seconds and then reconnect it.
- B. Then depress the **Reset** button and hold in for 10-12 seconds.
- 4. The **NF20MESH** is back to its factory defaults, you now need to reconfigure the broadband settings via the user interface.



NOTE - - If you had previously backed up your configuration, you can now restore your settings by uploading your **.config** file.

- 5. To reconfigure the broadband settings:
  - A. Open a web browser (such as Internet Explorer, Google Chrome or Firefox), type <a href="http://192.168.20.1">http://192.168.20.1</a> into the address bar and press **Enter.**
  - B. At the login screen, type the **Username** and the **Password** as printed on the sticker and click **Login**.
